### [Ridgewood Crew Closes Out The Fall Season At The Head of The Schuylkill Regatta](#)

**Ridgewood, New Jersey, October 30, 2022** – On October 30, 2022, Ridgewood Crew raced 19 boats on the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Head of The Schuylkill Regatta in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. According to the Head of the Schuylkill Regatta, the 2022 event will continue a tradition of exceptional fall racing that began fifty years ago in the home of American rowing. While the expansive scope of the two-day Regatta today bears little resemblance to its 1970 roots, the spirit of the Regatta endures: a fall race showcasing high-caliber crews as well as those new to the sport. This year, 261 clubs participated, with Ridgewood Crew racing nineteen boats.
